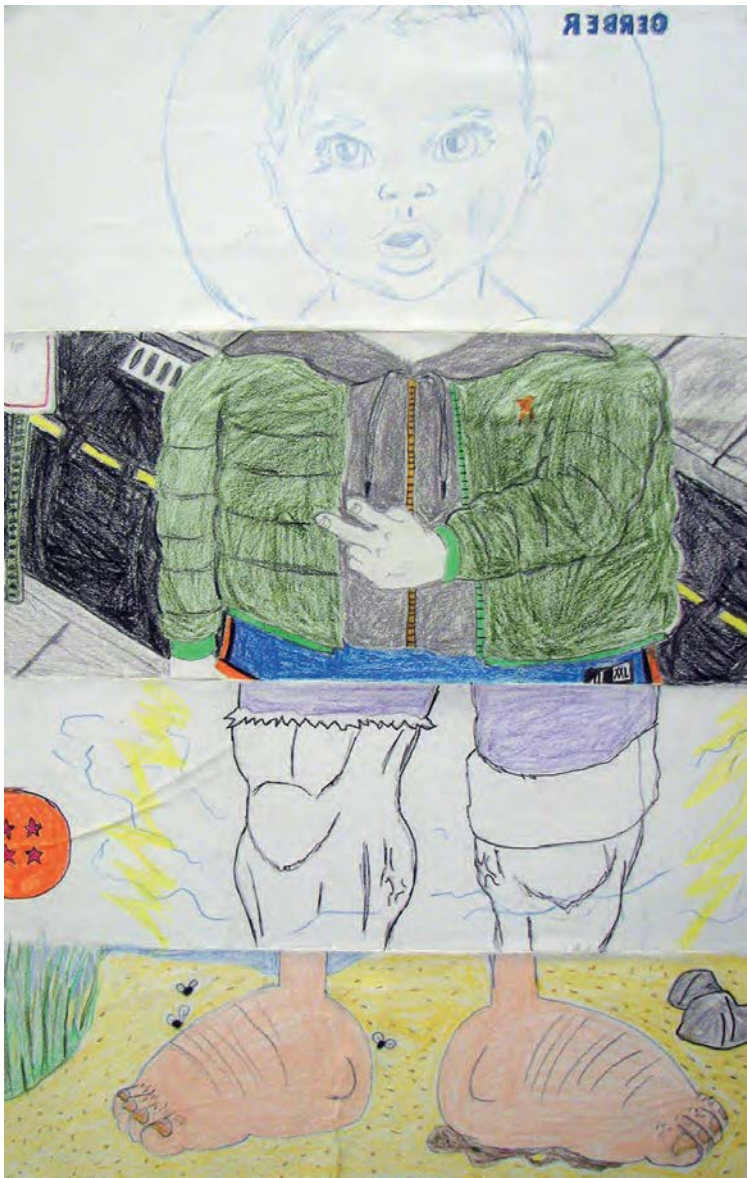

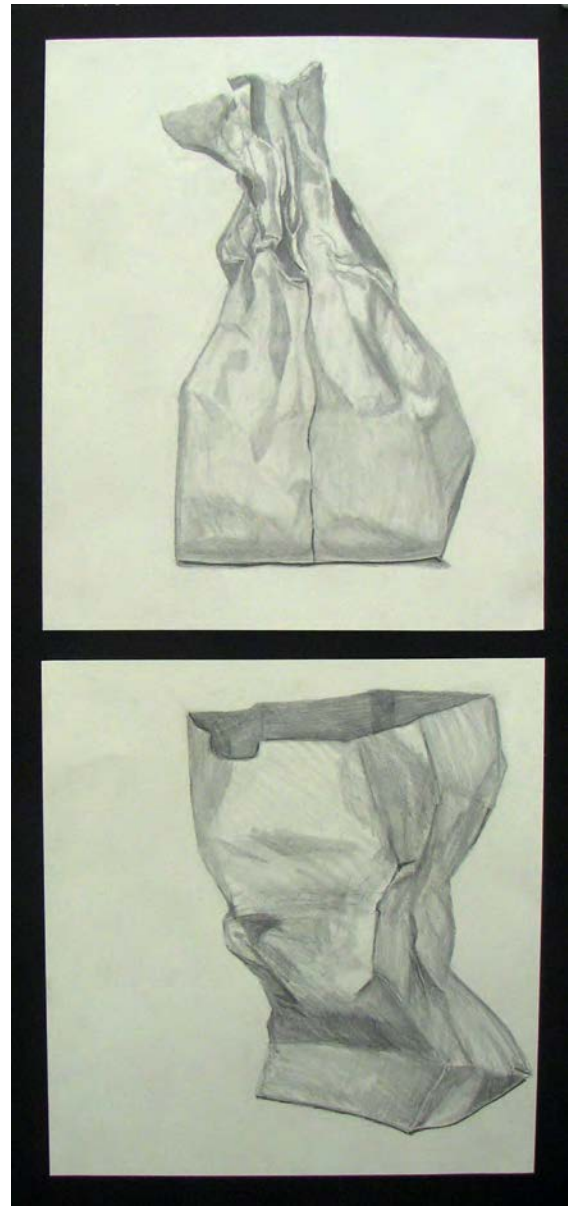

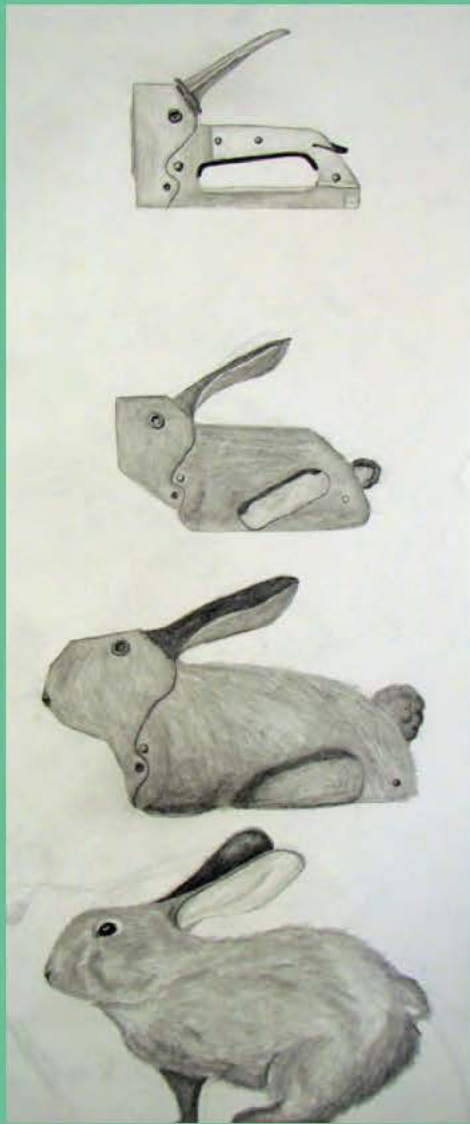
The Green Teen Music and Arts Festival

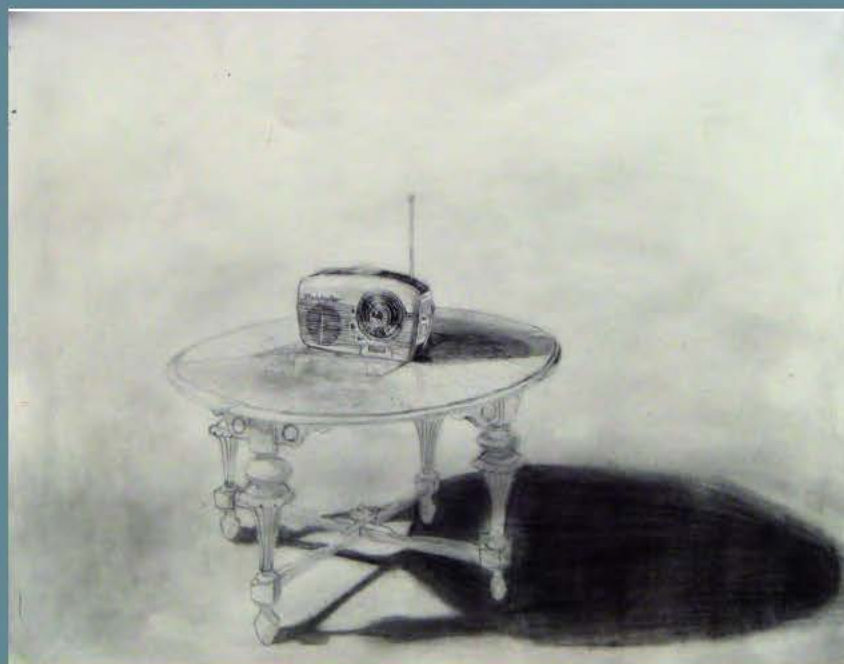

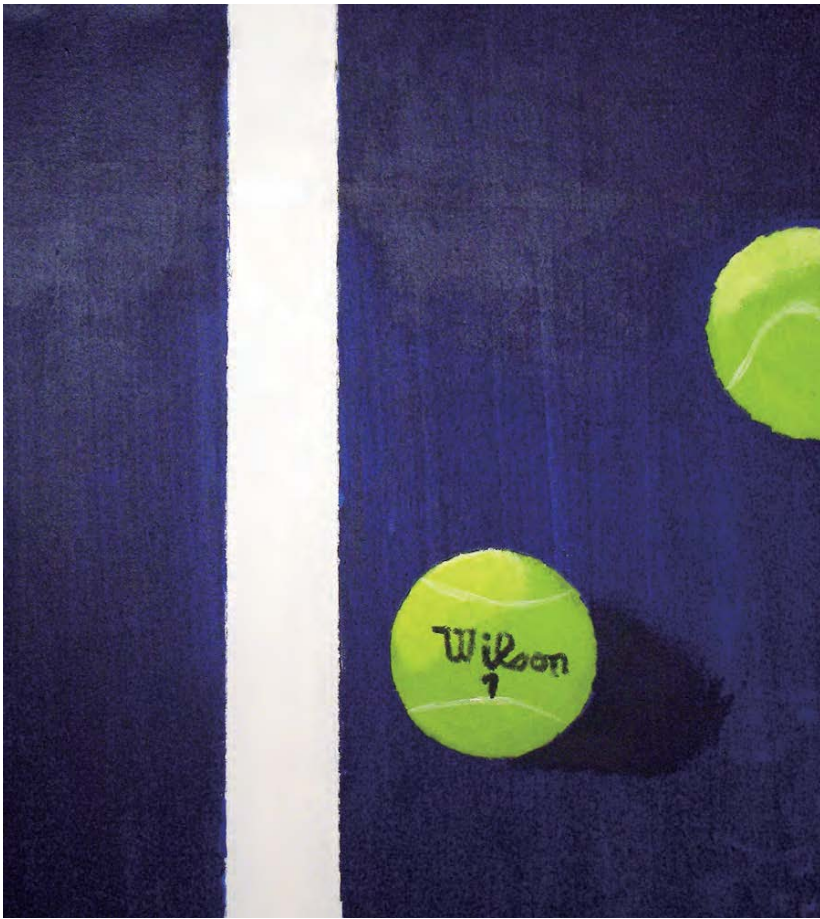
